

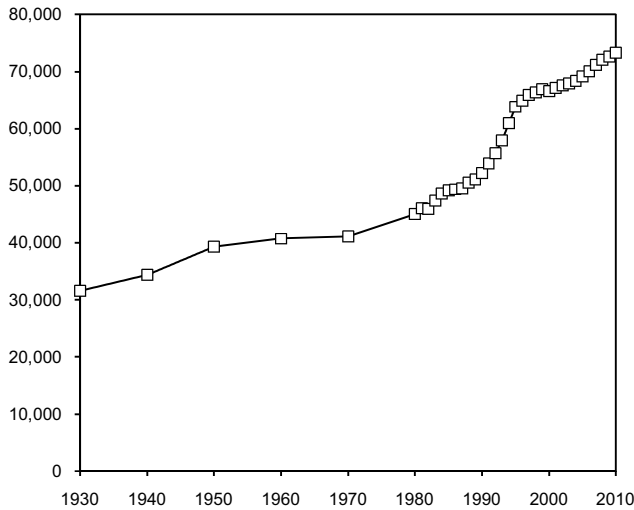

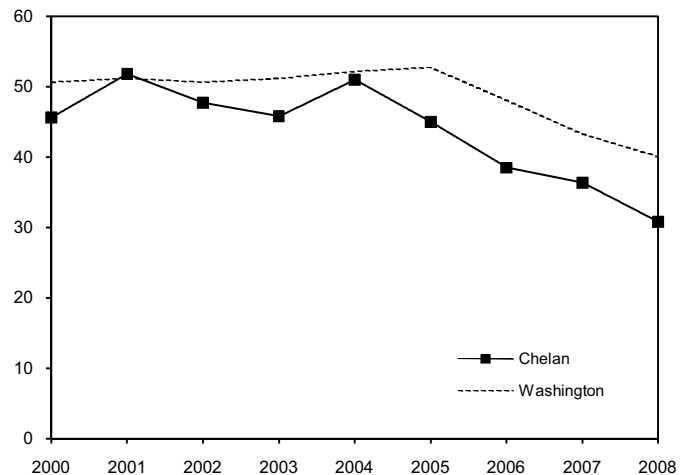

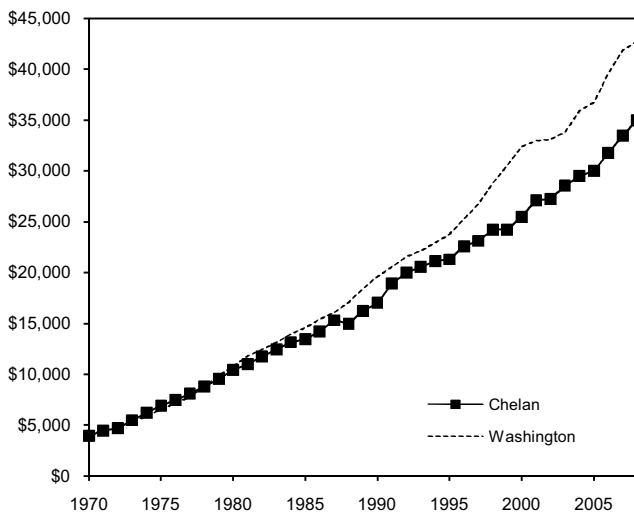
Total Crimes Reported Per 1000 Population



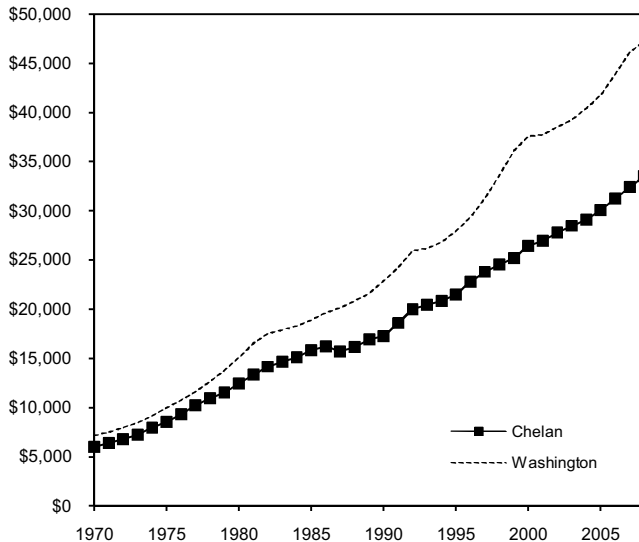

Per Capita Personal Income (\$)



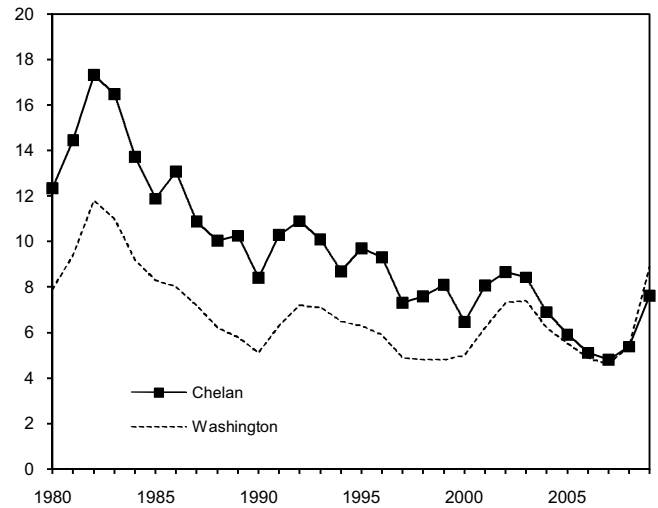

Annual Average Unemployment Rate (%)



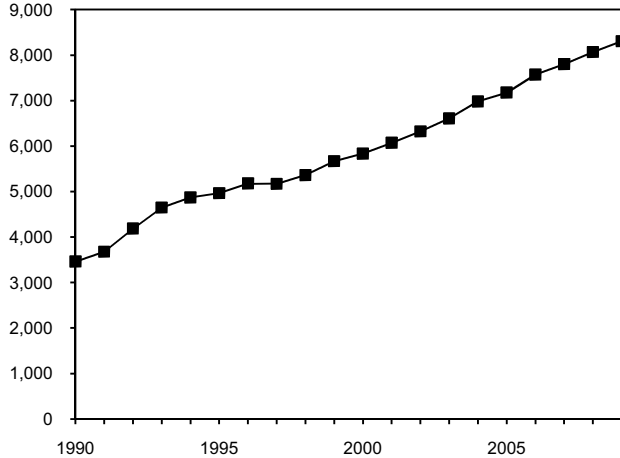

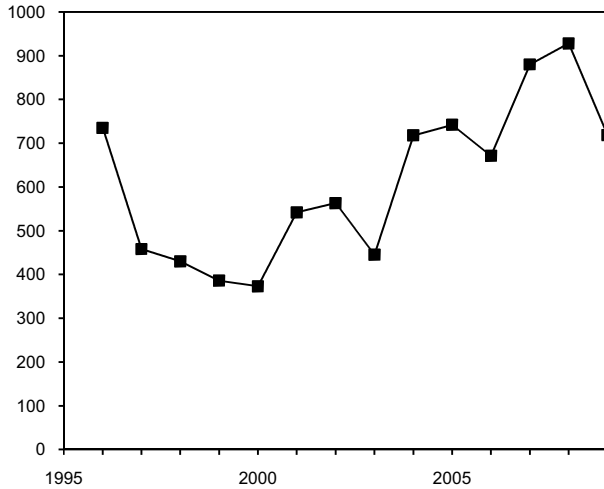
Number of Registered Businesses

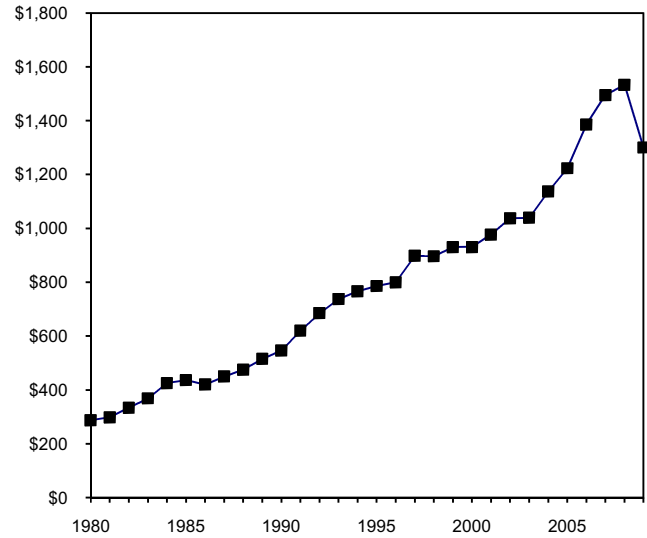

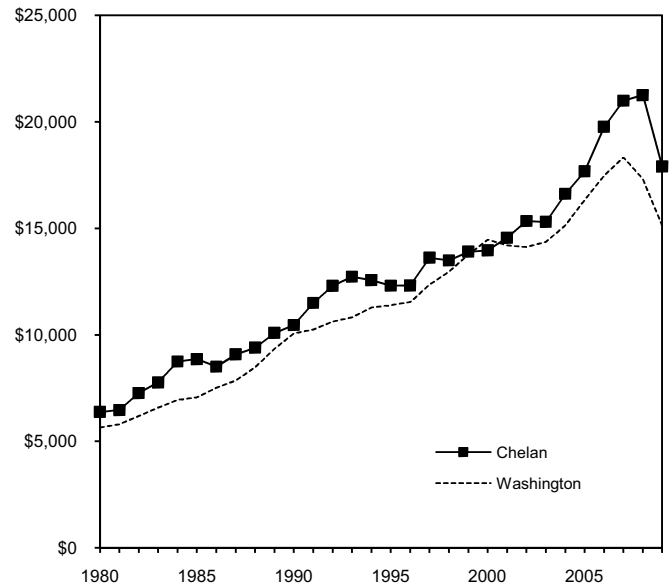

Total Taxable Retail Sales (millions of \$)



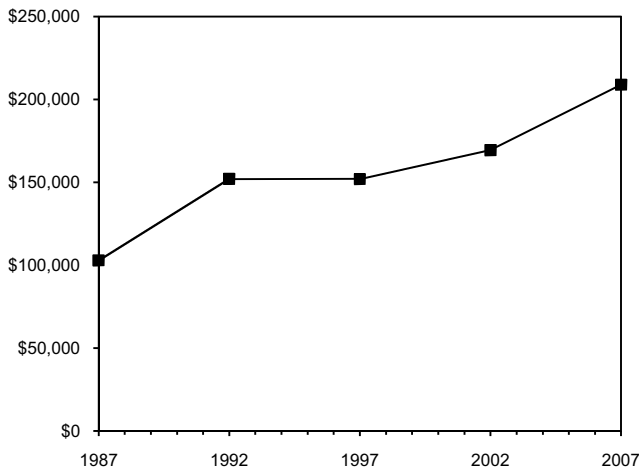
Taxable Retail Sales Per Capita (\$)

Market Value of Production (thousands of \$)



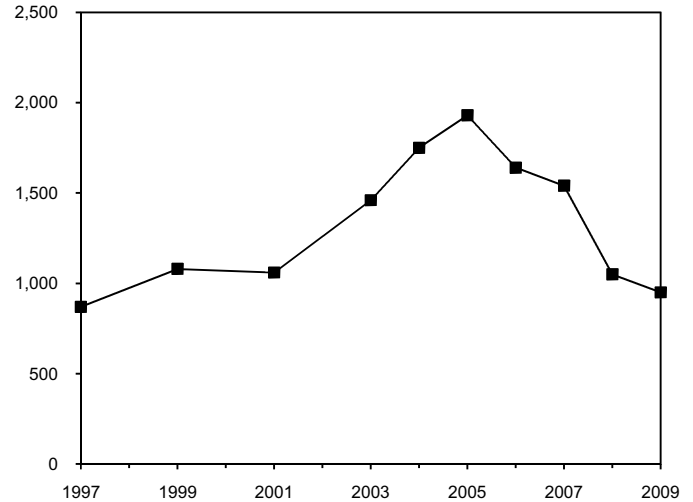
